2019 Community-Engaged Student Scholarships

Applications are now being accepted for the AAPHP Community-Engaged Scholarship program to support student-led public health intervention, research and/or evaluation projects conducted in a mutually beneficial partnership with the community. Activities used to complete the requirements for a thesis or internships may be eligible. Three scholarships are available:

- One scholarship to support an undergraduate student project (\$500).
- Two scholarships to support graduate student projects (\$1000 each).

Student eligibility requirements:

1. Enrolled in a public health degree program in an AAPHP member or affiliate institution.
2. Completed at least 15 semester units or 22.5 quarter units and are in excellent academic standing (minimum GPA of 3.5).
3. Are currently approved by their program to conduct a community-engaged project or thesis.
4. Are currently conducting or will begin the planned project by February 1, 2020.

Applications and supporting documents must be submitted to AAPHP at pamela.lyon@utah.edu by **April 15, 2019, 5:00 pm (MST). Scholarship awards will be announced by June 1.**

Only one scholarship will be awarded per program.

- 1) **Biosketch** - 250 word statement describing your background, including your academic, preparation, professional work history, and volunteer experience.
- 2) **Project Narrative** (2 page limit, 1.5 spacing, 1 inch margins, 12 point font) describing your community engaged intervention, research or evaluation project. Include an **abstract** (10 pts), **background** (10 pts), project/research/evaluation **aims or objectives** (20 pts), **plan/methods** (20 pts), and **plan for dissemination** of your results (10 pts). Also include a **description of how the scholarship will be used to support your project or thesis** (20 pts). Please provide a **timeline** for your project or thesis, along with the anticipated completion date (10pts).
- 3) **Unofficial graduate program transcript** - Please highlight your **GPA** with a yellow marker.
- 4) **Letter from your faculty advisor** recommending you and highlighting your ability to conduct and complete your project.
